



## ■ Safety rules Rail Service Center Rotterdam –publication 1 -2017

### General safety and site regulations on RSC Rotterdam

- Entry to the site is at your own risk.
- Instructions of the staff must be observed at all times.
- The use of prescribed protective equipment helmet, high visibility clothing and safety shoes is mandatory.
- Only follow the marked routes.
- Terminal tractors, reach stackers and other RSC vehicles ALWAYS have priority over other traffic.
- Parking vehicles is only allowed on the designated parking areas.
- Blocking transit and roads is forbidden.
- It is forbidden to drive underneath a load.
- During loading and unloading the driver must position himself next to the cabin, visible to the operational staff.

### Security and safety

RSC Rotterdam complies with strict laws and regulations, among other things, in the field of hazardous substances. In order to comply with this legislation, we may perform additional identity and / or ADR checks.

### Access terminal

The access is accessible through:

- Cargocard for truck drivers
- Staff badge for own employees
- Registration of visitors by process management

### Emergencies/incidents

All accidents, incidents such as leakages of hazardous substances and/or damages must be reported immediately to an RSC Rotterdam employee or the process manager: +31(0)10 4913645. In case of emergencies you must follow all instructions of the staff!

### Communication

Anyone entering the site is expected to be able to reasonably communicate in Dutch, English or German.

### Railway transitions

All level crossings at the RSC Rotterdam site are provided with traffic lights for safety reasons. As a warning for an approaching train, the lights will flash. In this case, any road traffic must clear the crossing. As long as the red light is flashing, crossing the level crossing is forbidden.
